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ECLKC Definitions – Types of Partnerships:

Communication/ Networking Level: Staff exchange information about community programs and services.

Coordination Level: Staff work with other community agencies to avoid duplication of efforts or to fill gaps in services.

Cooperation Level: Two or more programs conduct joint activities to meet their individual goals.

Collaboration Level: Programs working together toward common goals that could not be achieved by any program acting alone. Resources, information, and activities are shared by the collaborative partners to turn the goals into reality.
